SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 635, L. D. 2008, Bill, "AN ACT Reconstituting and More Effectively Coordinating the Maine Commission on Drug Abuse and the Division of Alcoholism and Providing an Alternative Sentencing for Violators of Drug Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first paragraph of that part designated "§ 7104." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'There is created within the Bureau of Rehabilitation of the Department of Health and Welfare the Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Prevention.'
