SENATE AMENDMENT" C" to S.P. 635, L.D. 2008, Bill, "AN ACT Reconstituting and More Effectively Coordinating the Maine Commission on Drug Abuse and the Division of Alcoholism and Providing an Alternative Sentencing for Violators of Drug Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first paragraph of that part designated "§ 7104." and inserting in place thereof the following:

There is created within the Bureau of Rehabilitation of the Department of Health and Welfare the Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Prevention. The office shall be under the immediate and full supervision of the Director, Bureau of Rehabilitation. The office shall be the sole agency of state government responsible for administration of this chapter. It shall be a separate, distinct administrative unit, which shall not be in any way integrated as a part or function of any other administrative unit of the department.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the Office of
Alcoholism and Drug abuse Prevention which will remain part of the
Bureau of Rehabilitation.
