AN ACT Relating to Town's Matching Funds for Resurfacing State
Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1104, amended. The first paragraph of section 1104 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

If any town shall in a single year increase its appropriation for state aid roads to an amount of 4 or 6 times the maximum amount which it may annually appropriate under section 1101 for use only in reconstructing improved state aid highways or in maintaining, including resurfacing, of improved state aid highways outside compact or built up sections of highway as defined in section 754, the department shall from any balance of said fund for state aid highways, and subject to section 1105, apportion a like increase of state aid. The proposed locations and type of work proposed under the provisions of this section shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend the law relating to town's matching funds for reconstructing state aid highways to include maintenance and resurfacing of state aid highways.
