SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 661, L. 
Amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 350. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1975.'
