HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to S.P. 678, L.D. 2044, Bill, "AN ACT
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following:

'Sec. 293. R. S., E. 28, § 2, sub-§ 18, amended. Subsection 18
of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is
further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:
Except that sales to overseas passengers passing through the airport
terminal facilities may be exempted from the calculations of the food
to liquor ratio in an amount to be determined by the Bureau of Alcoholic
Beverages and subject to such records and requirements as the bureau
may deem necessary for the purpose of carrying out this paragraph.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow International Airport
restaurants to serve liquor to overseas passengers without jeopardizing
the requirements for a Class A restaurant.
