SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 678, L. D. 2044, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 133 the following:

'Sec. 133-A. R. S., T. 23, §3004, amended. The last paragraph
of section 3004 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by
chapter 456 of the public laws of 1973, is repealed as follows:

A-town-way-which-has-not-been-maintained-by-the-town-for-a
period-of-20-years-shall-thereby-be-discontinued-by-operation-of-law.
Such-discontinuance-by-operation-of-law-shall-be-presumed-to-relegate
the-town-way-to-the-status-of-a-private-way.

Sec. 133-B. Effective date. Section 133-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to resolve the conflict between public law 456 and public law 505 of 1973.
