SENATE AMENDMENT " G" to S. P. 678, L. D. 2044, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 290. Commissione: of Educational and Cultural Services; authorized to grant easement. RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services in the name of the State of Maine is authorized and directed to grant an easement to Portland Water District, its successors and assigns, to install and maintain an underground electrical cable along and under land owned by the State of Maine on Mackworth Island, Town of Falmouth, extending in a westerly direction from Causeway Road at the north end of Mackworth Island to the chemical feed structure, a distance of approximately 640 feet, following generally along existing nature path.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to grant an easement to Portland Water District to install and maintain an underground electrical cable at Mackworth Island, Town of Falmouth, to provide electric power for a water treatment building for Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf.
