SENATE AMENDMENT "K" to S.P. 678, L.D. 2044, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 187 the following:

'Sec. 187-A. R. S., T. 29, § 363, amended. The last paragraph of section 363 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 529 of the public laws of 1973 is amended to read as follows:

The Secretary of State may issue temporary plates and certificates to dealers who request them under such rules and regulations as he shall seem necessary and shall receive $75 \neq 50 \neq$ per plate.

Sec. 187-B. Effective date. Section 187-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after the adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an error in the fee for temporary plates and certificates to dealers.
