## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1630, L. D. 2045, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Contributions and Expenditures to Influence Direct Initiative or Referendum Legislation."

Amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line, after the enacting clause, the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Secretary of State shall establish forms of substantially the same form, content and intent as required of federal candidates by federal law in general elections for use in carrying out this section.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to bring the bill into conformance with the legislative order passed ordering this bill to be written by the Election Laws Committee.
