SENATE AMENDMENT"A." to S.P. 685, L.D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide a Subsidy to Communities with Private School Enrollments."

(same in L.D.)

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting in the 2nd/line of the first paragraph after the amending clause, after the underlined words "costs in the" the following underlined word: 'nonprofit'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'10. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services shall reimburse any municipality for providing the transportation of school children to and from schools other than public schools, except such schools as are operated for profit in whole or in part.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$645,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
