STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Providing Additional Funding to Support the In-School Instructional Television Broadcasting Contract with WCBB-TV.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, educational television is a vital link in Maine's educational system; and

Whereas, full instructional in-school services over the public broadcasting system are vital to the best interests of Maine's school pupils; and

Whereas, the following legislation is essential to continue such in-school instructional services from early February to the end of the fiscal year; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$26,400 for instructional in-school services by public broadcasting. The breakdown shall be as follows:
