COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1660,  
L. D. 2053, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Emergency  
Medical Training for Ambulance and Rescue  
Personnel."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd  
line (2nd line in L. D.) the figure "\$45,000"  
and inserting in place thereof the figure  
'\$25,000'

Further amend said Bill in the last line  
of the 2nd paragraph (same in L. D.) by striking  
out the figure and punctuation "\$25,000." and  
inserting in place thereof the following:  
'\$20,000. This represents 75% state funds to  
be matched by 25% from other non-state funds.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out  
all of the last paragraph before the Statement  
of Fact.

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the appropriation to  
\$25,000 of which \$20,000 is for section 1 on  
a 75% state, 25% non-state matching basis. The  
balance of \$5,000 is to provide for section 2  
with no matching required. This amendment  
also eliminates section 3 from the bill.
