AN ACT Relating to Applications for Absentee Ballots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1253, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1253 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

1. Applications available. On request, the clerk shall furnish to any person a reasonable number of ballot applications ~~to any person~~ which shall have been printed in different colors every 2 years starting in the year 1974, for use in all primary, special and general elections.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Printing the applications on different colors of paper for every biennium election will make applications secured the previous year obsolete.
