COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " H. P. 1671, L. D. 2064, Bill, "AN ACT Converting Somerville Plantation into the Town of Somerville."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Legislative district. Until the next legislative apportionment of Representatives, the Town of Somerville shall remain in the same legislative district in which Somerville Plantation is now classed.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 21st and 22nd lines of Sec. 3. (22nd in L.D.) the following words: "number of the qualified voters" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'vote for all candidates for Governor cast at the next previous gubernatorial election'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 3." and inserting in place thereof the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 4.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for the Representative District in which the future Town of Somerville should be placed and to decrease the number of qualified voters necessary to pass this referendum.
