HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1673, L. D. 2066,  
Bill, "AN ACT Repealing Discount Sale Price of  
Liquor in One State Store."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at  
the end before the period the following words:

'and Lowering the State Liquor Tax'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all  
of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, §451, amended. The  
3rd sentence of section 451 of Title 28 of the  
Revised Statutes, as amended by section 66 of  
chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is  
further amended to read as follows:

Special orders by the commission for unstocked  
merchandise shall be priced at not less than  
75% 65% over actual cost delivered F.O.B.  
warehouse.'

Fiscal Note

It is estimated loss of revenue to the General  
Fund for one year will be \$1,500,000.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to lower the  
state liquor tax from 75% to 65%.
