COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1684,
L. D. 2077, "AN ACT Providing Funds for Spruce
Budworm Control and Surveys."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything
after the enacting clause and before the
emergency clause and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from
the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
the sum of \$595,450 to be expended by the Director
of the Bureau of Forestry, or his agents, for
spruce budworm control and for research. The rest
of the funds are to be supplied from the balance of
funds in the spruce budworm account and the
Federal Government. Any unexpended balances of
this appropriation and funds appropriated by the
resolves of 1973, chapter 18, shall not lapse but
shall remain a continuing carrying account until
June 30, 1975.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is to reduce appropriation by
\$36,600 which was to be expended in fiscal year
1975 and would have established a continuing
program and by \$128,000 which is the balance
available from prior appropriations that the
Bureau of Forestry says will be available for
assisting on the funding of the 1974 project.
