IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Clarifying Law on Records of Bank Loans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 9, § 1042, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1042 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Such record shall show that the making of such loans or investments have been made with the approval of has been approved or ratified by the directors or executive committee of said company and shall indicate such particulars respecting such loans and investments as the commissioner shall direct.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to make clear that bank loans do not necessarily have to be approved prior to the granting by the Board of Directors but may be ratified thereafter.
