HOUSE AMENDMENT"B" to H.P. 1687, L.D. 2080, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Solid Waste Collection and Disposal System in Kennebec County."

Amend said Bill in the title by inserting at the end before the period, the following: 'and Somerset County'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R.S.,T. 30, §§421-423, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding the following new sections, 421 to 423, to read as follows:

<u>§421.</u> Powers and duties of the Kennebec and Somerset County commissioners

The county commissioners of Kennebec County and Somerset County are empowered to operate a solid waste collection and disposal system jointly or separately.

§422. Towns and others served

All towns and counties may be served. The county commissiones may contract with other towns or counties for collection and disposal services.

§423. Fees from towns and counties

Each town or county served may be assessed for the cost of the operation. Such costs shall be prorated on the basis of population, as determined by the last decennial densus.'

It is the intent of this amendment to permit the county commissioners to negotiate services outside the counties.
