STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to Clarify the Law Relating to Disposal of Septic Tank or Cesspool Wastes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4106, additional. Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4106, to read as follows:

§ 4106. Use of approved municipal facilities

The Department of Environmental Protection shall not approve or renew its approval of any location or facility owned by any person, firm, corporation or other legal entity within the jurisdiction of a municipality which provides an approved municipal facility for the disposal of septic tank or cesspool wastes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would insure that the disposal facilities provided by a municipality for septic tank and cesspool wastes would be the only approved facility in a community.
