HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1693, L. D. 2086, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Maine Maritime Academy to Grant Honorary Degrees."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is desirable that the Maine Maritime Academy has positive power to grant honorary degrees; and

Whereas, the academy should have such power as soon as possible in order to grant such honorary degrees for the benefit of the academy in the spring of 1974; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
