IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Sheila Herbert of Chelsea for Damage to Motor Vehicle by State Ward.

Sheila Herbert; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$196.97 to be paid to Sheila Herbert of Chelsea as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for damage to her motor vehicle by a state ward.

STATEMENT OF FACT
