AN ACT Relating to Safety Glazing.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2051, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2051 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 237 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

2. **Safety glazing material.** "Safety glazing material" means any glazing material, such as tempered glass, laminated glass, wire glass or rigid plastic, which meets the test requirements of the then current ANSI Standard ~~Z-97.1~~ ~~1966~~ Z97.1 and such further requirements as may be adopted by the Department of Public Safety after notice and hearing and which are so constructed, treated or combined with other materials as to minimize the likelihood of cutting and piercing injuries resulting from human contact with the glazing material.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Since this legislation was written, a 1972 standard has been published and these standards are continually being updated. This amendment would permit application of the then current edition, negating a legislative change in the year with each such revision.
