**AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Malt Liquor at
Central Maine Youth Center in Lewiston.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Central Maine Youth Center has operated in Lewiston as a community project since January 7, 1973; and

Whereas, it is essential that said Central Maine Youth Center carry on its activities as often as possible, at as full a capacity as possible and provide its programs for the people of the area; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 807, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 807 to read as follows:

§ 807. Central Maine Youth Center

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the commission is authorized to adopt rules, requirements and regulations permitting the sale of malt

liquor at the Central Maine Youth Center located in Lewiston to be consumed on the premises, which shall not include the arena where ice hockey is played.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to permit the sale of malt beverages within certain areas of the Central Maine Youth Center at Lewiston.
