STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Authorizing Municipalities with Public Auditoriums to have a Liquor License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 251, amended. Section 251 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any municipality having a public auditorium or civic center may be issued a liquor license therefor, without any requirement for the approval of the application by the municipal officers.
