AN ACT Relating to Hearing for Provisional Motor Vehicle Licensee on
Suspensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2241, amended. The last paragraph of section 2241 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 118 of the public laws of 1969 and as amended by chapter 361 of the public laws of 1973, is further amended by adding 3 new sentences before the last sentence, to read as follows:

Except that a hearing may be requested of the Secretary of State, and the Secretary of State shall afford said provisional licensee opportunity for hearing as soon as practicable after receipt of such request. Upon such hearing, the Secretary of State, for good cause shown, may continue, modify or rescind the suspension. From the date the Secretary of State receives notice of request for hearing, until the Secretary of State continues, modifies or rescinds the suspension, said suspension shall not be effective.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to afford provisional licensees an opportunity to be heard in cases of automatic suspension of the provisional license for motor vehicle moving violations.
