SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 707, L.D.
2119, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Payments in
Behalf of Maine Students at Out-of-State
Graduate Schools."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything
after the amending clause and before the
emergency clause and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'It was the intent of the Legislature that the
needs analysis tests for Maine students attending
out-of-state graduate schools would be applied
effective the 1974-75 school year.'
