
SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " " to S. P. 713, L. D. 2125, Bill, "AN ACT Lowering the Maximum Age of Juvenile Offenders."

Amend said amendment by adding at the end of section 2 a new sentence to read as follows:

'This paragraph shall not apply to habitual truancy by a juvenile under Title 20, chapter 105.'
