COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 720,  
L. D. 2132, "RESOLVE, Authorizing the Town  
of Bingham to Remove Sand Bars at Confluence  
of Austin Stream and Kennebec River."

Amend said resolve by striking out everything  
after the emergency preamble and before the  
emergency clause and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Town of Bingham; authorized. Resolved:  
That the Town of Bingham is authorized to remove  
the sand bars and natural obstructions at the  
confluence of Austin Stream and the Kennebec  
River for a distance of 4300 feet upstream from  
the confluence for 3 years.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change  
the distance of feet from 1200 to 4300 feet and  
to put a time limit on the number of years.
