COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 722,  
L. D. 2134, Bill, "An Act Relating to School  
Buses."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of  
section 5 and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is  
appropriated from the General Fund to the  
Department of Educational and Cultural Services  
the sum of \$15,000 to carry out the purposes  
of this Act. The breakdown shall be as
