

SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S. P. 722, L. D. 2134, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Buses."

Amend said Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§ 2020." by striking out in the 3rd line from the end (same in L. D.) after the underlined word "Commission" the following: ', while transporting school children, shall comply with all of the requirements of school buses, except that they shall be exempted from the vehicle color requirements until September 1, 1977' and inserting in place thereof the following: 'shall be exempt from the provisions of this chapter'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would allow mass transit vehicles currently transporting children to schools along with other passengers where necessary in large cities to continue this practice without causing confusion to motorists and passengers.
