**RESOLVE, in Favor of Archelas Duchesneau of Sabattus for Damage by
Moose.**

Archelas Duchesneau; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated to Archelas Duchesneau of Sabattus from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$379.80 for personal property damage caused by moose.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize \$379.80 to reimburse Archelas Duchesneau, Greene Road, Sabattus, for damage to his personal property, an automobile hit by a moose on a public highway.
