COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 731,
L. D. 2143, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct an
Inconsistency in the District Attorney Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the
beginning of the first line after the enacting
clause the following underlined abbreviation
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at
the end, before the Statement of Fact, the
following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall
become effective January 1, 1975.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to conform
the effective date of the legislation being
amended with the effective date of the full-time
district attorney law.
