## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 106TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 737, L. D. 2149, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for a Credit in Maine Income Tax Law for Investment in Pollution Control Facilities."

Amend said Bill in the 2nd line of subsection 1 of that part designated "§5202" by striking out the underlined figure "78" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '5%'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after subsection 4 of that part designated "§5202" a new subsection 4-A. to read as follows:

'4-A. Tax credits allowed by this section shall be applicable only in regard to expenditures made prior to any applicable statutory or regulatory time limits.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the amount of allowable tax credit for investment in pollution control facilities from 7% to 5% and to insure that only expenditures made prior to established deadlines qualify for such a credit.
