#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Providing Funds for Implementation of a State-wide Program of Safety of Dams and Reservoirs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Soil and Water Conservation Commission the sum of \$77,541 to carry out the purposes of a state-wide program of safety of dams and reservoirs. The breakdown shall be as follows:
