COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 756,  
L. D. 2166, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment  
to the Constitution Broadening the Limitation for  
Revenues Derived from Taxation of Vehicles Used  
on Public Highways and Fuels Used by Such  
Vehicles.

Amend said Resolution in the 3rd paragraph  
by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines (same  
in L.D.) the underlined words "and for any  
other purposes which the Department of Transportation  
has a duty to perform" and inserting in place  
thereof the following: ', except that up to 25%  
of such revenues may be expended for other surface  
transportation purposes which the Department of  
Transportation has a duty to perform'

Further amend said Resolution in the 3rd  
paragraph from the end before the Statement of  
Fact by inserting at the end before the punctuation  
the following: 'so that up to 25% of such ~~revenue~~  
may be ~~expended~~ for other ~~surface~~ ~~transportation~~  
~~purposes~~ which the Department of Transportation  
has a ~~duty to perform~~'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit  
the amount of dedicated funds which may be used  
for other purposes and to provide that these  
purposes are related to surface transportation.
