**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Gerald Perkins of Bucksport for Loss of Beehives
by Bear.**

Gerald Perkins; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$196.40 to be paid to Gerald Perkins of Bucksport as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of beehives and honey destroyed by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Perkins lost hives, frames and 80 pounds of honey because of damage by bear.
