HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1732, L.D. 2176,
Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Various County
Officers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Application. All regular employees
of the county, other than elective officials, may
be granted pay raises in accordance with Title 30,
section 3. Elected officials under this Act may
only receive increases in salary upon commencing a
new term of office.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to clarify
the circumstances by which pay raises may be
granted to elected officials and employees of the
county.
