HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1732, L. D. 2176, Bill,  
"AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Various County Officers.

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out  
in the last line of the 4th paragraph after the  
enacting clause (same in L.D.) the underlined figure  
"\$9,305" and inserting in place thereof the following:  
'\$9,820'

Statement of Fact

It is the purpose of this amendment to eliminate  
the 5.5% pay increase and provide \$1,000 increase in-  
stead due to renewal of income from fees of approxi-  
mately \$2,000 in the regular session county salary  
bill. Current practices by registers of probate  
do not comply with State Statutes. Title 30,  
.. section 2 and Title 18, section 251 state that all  
fees collected by county officers are for the use  
of the county.
