IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Various County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd to the 17th paragraphs of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, except for those parts which relate to the county attorneys, as amended, are further amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1974.
