STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Limiting the Amount of Money Spent on Promoting or Opposing Referendum Questions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1395-A, additional. Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1395-A to read as follows:

§ 1395-A. —referenda

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no person, association, corporation or combination thereof shall dispense, to influence the outcome of any referendum, an amount of money greater than 10¢ multiplied by the number of votes cast for all candidates for Governor at the next previous gubernatorial election.
