STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to a Maine Resident's Preference in State Employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 557, amended. The first paragraph of section 557 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 568 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

In making appointments to any position on an open competitive basis in the classified service or recruiting for the same, preference shall be given to eitizens residents of the State of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The term "resident" and "citizen" are not legally synonymous terms. This bill corrects this technicality of the law intended to provide a preference in employment to Maine residents.
