COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1739, L. D. 2185, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Income from the Public Reserved Lands."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'<u>R. S., T. 30, §4163, sub-§1, amended.</u> Subsection 1 of section 4163 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 15 of chapter 628 and as amended by section 20 of chapter 460, both of the public laws of 1973, is further amended to read as follows:

1. Income. All income received by the Commissioner of the Department of Conservation from the public reserved lands from the sale of timber, grass, gravel and lease fees shall be deposited with the Treasurer of State to be credited to the General Fund organized plantation involved in the sale.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to clarify the language used in the original bill by indicating the nature of the income and place where it will be credited.
