HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A"
to H. P. 1739, L. D. 2185, Bill, "AN ACT Relating
to Income from the Public Reserved Lands."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all
of the last paragraph before the Statement of
Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The assessors in plantations organized prior
to March 1, 1974 shall have power to review and
comment prior to final actions taken by the com-
missioner under section 4162, subsection 4, on the
public lots located within their respective
plantations.'

The purpose of this amendment is to permit
the assessors of plantations the power to review
and comment on actions taken by the commissioner.
