STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to Income from the Public Reserved Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4163, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 4163 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 15 of chapter 628 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to read as follows:

§ 4163. Funds from the public reserved lands

1. Income. All income received by the Forest Commissioner from the public reserved lands shall be deposited with the Treasurer of State to be credited to the General Fund Plantation Account.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act that proceeds from the sale of timber, grass, and gravel be credited to the plantation involved in the sale.
