SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 762, L. D. 2193, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Hours of Sale of Liquor in Take-out Stores to Correspond with On-premises Establishments."

Amend said Bill in the last line before the Statement of Fact (same in L.D.) by striking out the figure and abbreviation "1 a.m." and inserting in place thereof the following: '1-a.m. midnight.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment in keeping with curtailment of church, school and other activities due to the energy crisis to realign hours for the sale of liquor.
