AN ACT Relating to Bulldozing of St. John River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Harvesting of sand and gravel from the St. John River. The provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 2205, shall not apply to the harvesting of sand and gravel from the St. John River.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt the harvesting of sand and gravel from the St. John River from the law regulating the bulldozing of rivers, streams and brooks.
