**AN ACT Providing Funds for Members of the State Police for Expenses
Incurred as such Members.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Police; appropriation. There is appropriated to the State Police for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 the sum of \$40,330 from the General Fund and \$120,990 from the General Highway Fund for the following purpose. Each member of the State Police shall receive \$520 to reimburse such member for expenses incurred in carrying out their statutory duties, such as cleaning equipment, telephone, etc.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reimburse each member of the State Police for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
