SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 767, L. D. 2198, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Administrative Assistant, Supreme Judicial Court."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice shall receive an annual compensation established by the Chief Justice.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have the salary of the Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice established by the Chief Justice and to delete the appropriation from the bill.
