STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR

AN ACT to Provide Funds to Aid Construction of Kenduskeag Stream Park.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Allocated. There is allocated from the proceeds of the bond issue authorized by chapter 138 of the private and special laws of 1973 and ratified by the people of Maine the sum of \$150,000 to the City of Bangor as the local share to match federal funds for the development of Kenduskeag Stream Park in Bangor.
