AN ACT to Clarify the Law on Interstate Transportation of Shellfish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4306, amended. Section 4306 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of chapter 82 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding after the first paragraph, 2 new paragraphs to read as follows:

Each person, firm or corporation applying for an interstate shellfish transportation license shall be the holder of a current valid interstate shellfish certificate issued by the appropriate agency in the state or country of domicile or of incorporation. The interstate shellfish certificate number issued to the person, firm or corporation must appear on the application form for the license issued under this section.

Persons, firms or corporations, applying for an interstate shellfish transportation license who are domiciled in a state or country which does not issue interstate shellfish certificates, may be issued a license if they purchase the shellfish in accordance with section 4302-B, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, and the vehicle in which the shellfish are transported meets the standards set forth for interstate shellfish dealers domiciled in the State of Maine.
